- Must be able to read basic blue prints and electrical schematics
- Required to test and initial electrified components for function
- · Notify Production Supervisor when maintenance supplies and parts need to be ordered or replenished prior to running out
- Maintain the general equipment, machinery and work area. Keep the equipment and area clean and free of excess debris
- · Debug and trouble shoot electrical problems

## Job Qualifications:

- · High School Diploma or equivalent required
- · Must be able to use basic hand tools
- · Must be self-motivated
- · At least two years of electrical industrial electric experience, including panel building
- Must be able to read basic blue prints and electrical schematics
- Handle materials with forklifts and overhead cranes as needed

- Must be able to communicate with other employees effectively
