- Must be certifiable and able to pass the certification test in accordance with the AWS D14.1 specifications
- SMAW, MCAW, GMAW and spray arc welding experience preferred
- Must be able to operate and use flame cutting equipment
- Use and read basic hand tools; including but not limited to grinders, drills, tape measures
- Handle materials with forklifts and overhead cranes as needed
- Required to travel throughout all the facilities
- Must be able to communicate with factory supervision effectively and follow company policies
